A BILL FOR AN ACT 101 CONCERNING THE GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE OF THE STATE 102 HISTORICAL SOCIETY, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, 103 CHANGING THE METHOD OF APPOINTMENT OF THE BOARD OF 104 DIRECTORS AND CREATING A DIRECTORS COUNCIL.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Legislative Audit Committee. Currently, the Colorado historical society (historical society) is governed by a board of directors (board) elected by members of the historical society. Under the bill, the method

of selecting the board is changed to a board appointed by the governor. The governor appoints 5 members with the consent of the senate. Four additional members are selected by the board and submitted to the governor for approval and appointment with the consent of the senate. Members appointed to the board have the authority to act on behalf of the board prior to confirmation by the senate. Terms of members of the board are 3 years, but initial terms are staggered.

There is also established a directors council (council) to advise the board. Members of the council are elected by members of the historical society. The board establishes the number of members of the council and their terms.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly finds and declares that:

- (a) The state historical society has been a Colorado nonprofit corporation since its founding in 1879 and is presently a nonprofit corporation under the "Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act", articles 121 to 137 of title 7, C.R.S.
- (b) The state historical society has also been an educational institution of the state since 1915 and is a division of the department of higher education, transferred by a **type 1** transfer to the department of higher education. Changing the method of selecting the board from a board elected by the historical society's members to a board appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate will better balance the historical society's needs as a nonprofit corporation with those of a state entity and strengthen and enhance its relationship with the department of higher education and the executive and legislative branches.
- (c) The creation of a directors council is intended to provide the board with advice, counsel, and expertise from others who are committed to the historical society's educational mission.

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1	(d) The provisions of this act are not intended to alter the state
2	historical society's status as a Colorado nonprofit corporation; except that
3	the provisions of this act relating to the selection, terms, and size of the
4	board of directors govern over any inconsistent provision in the
5	"Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act", the state historical
6	society's amended and restated articles, or its bylaws.
7	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 24-80-201 as
8	follows:
9	24-80-201. Society an educational institution. The state
10	historical society, an incorporated organization, is hereby declared to be
11	one of the educational institutions of the state of Colorado. THE STATE
12	HISTORICAL SOCIETY EXERCISES ITS POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS
13	UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS IF IT WERE
14	TRANSFERRED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY A TYPE 1 TRANSFER UNDER THE
15	PROVISIONS OF THE "ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION ACT OF 1968",
16	ARTICLE 1 OF THIS TITLE.
17	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-80-201.5 and
18	24-80-201.7 as follows:
19	24-80-201.5. State historical society - board - appointment -
20	powers and duties - repeal. (1) Effective <u>July 1, 2015,</u> the board of
21	DIRECTORS OF THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY, REFERRED TO IN THIS PART
22	2 AS THE "BOARD" OR "BOARD OF DIRECTORS", CONSISTS OF NINE
23	MEMBERS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION.
24	(2) (a) (I) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT, WITH THE CONSENT OF
25	THE SENATE, FIVE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD. THE GOVERNOR SHALL MAKE
26	The initial appointments on or before $\underline{June 1}$, 2015 , to be effective
27	<u>July 1, 2015.</u> If there is a vacancy of a member appointed pursuant

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1	TO THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I), THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A NEW
2	MEMBER OF THE BOARD FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM.
3	(II) (A) THE FOUR REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ARE
4	SELECTED BY THE BOARD FOR APPOINTMENT BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE
5	CONSENT OF THE SENATE. THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT THE NAME OR NAMES
6	OF PERSONS SELECTED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO THE GOVERNOR.
7	UPON APPOINTMENT BY THE GOVERNOR, THE NAME OF THE APPOINTEE IS
8	FORWARDED TO THE SENATE FOR CONFIRMATION. IF THE GOVERNOR DOES
9	NOT APPROVE OF A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE BOARD, THE GOVERNOR
10	SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD OF HIS OR HER DECISION, AND THE BOARD
11	SHALL SUBMIT A NEW RECOMMENDATION. THE INITIAL APPOINTMENTS ARE
12	EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015.
13	(B) FOR THE INITIAL SELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS, THE
14	MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS HOLDING ELECTIVE OFFICE AS OF
15	$\underline{\text{June}}$ 1, 2015, shall select four persons and submit their names to
16	THE GOVERNOR ON OR BEFORE <u>June 15</u> , 2015, Pursuant to
17	SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II).
18	(C) IF THERE IS A VACANCY OR AT THE EXPIRATION OF THE TERM
19	OF A MEMBER APPOINTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II), THE
20	BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL SUBMIT A NAME OR NAMES TO THE
21	GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS
22	SUBPARAGRAPH (II) FOR APPOINTMENT, REAPPOINTMENT, OR TO FILL AN
23	UNEXPIRED TERM.
24	(b) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS PARAGRAPH (b),
25	MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SERVE THREE-YEAR TERMS. THE MEMBERS FIRST
26	APPOINTED TO THE BOARD TAKE OFFICE ON <u>JULY 1, 2015.</u> OF THE
27	APPOINTMENTS OF MEMBERS TO TAKE OFFICE ON JULY 1, 2015, THE

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2	(I) THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO HAVE TERMS EXPIRING ON
3	<u>July 1, 2016,</u> including one member who is appointed pursuant to
4	SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2);
5	(II) THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO HAVE TERMS EXPIRING ON
6	<u>July 1, 2017,</u> including one member who is appointed pursuant to
7	SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2); AND
8	(III) THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO HAVE TERMS EXPIRING ON
9	<u>July 1, 2018,</u> including two members who are appointed pursuant
10	TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2).
11	THEREAFTER, THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ARE THREE
12	YEARS.
13	(c) In appointing the nine members of the board, the
14	GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT COLLECTIVELY THE MEMBERS POSSESS
15	THE SKILLS IN STATE FINANCIAL, LEGAL, AND REGULATORY EXPERTISE AS
16	REQUIRED TO OVERSEE THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND SHALL
17	CONSIDER BOTH GEOGRAPHIC AND CULTURAL DIVERSITY OF THE NINE
18	MEMBERS. THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT NO MORE THAN FIVE MEMBERS
19	FROM THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY.
20	(d) Members appointed to the board have the authority to
21	ACT ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD PRIOR TO OBTAINING CONFIRMATION BY
22	THE SENATE.
23	(3) THE BOARD APPOINTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION
24	CONSTITUTES THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE STATE HISTORICAL
25	SOCIETY AND SHALL EXERCISE ALL OF THE POWERS, DUTIES AND
26	FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD AND THE HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INCLUDING
27	THOSE SET FORTH IN THIS PART 2 OR OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.

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GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE:

9	24-80-201.7. Directors council - creation - election - duties.
10	(1) There is created the directors council of the state
11	HISTORICAL SOCIETY, REFERRED TO IN THIS PART 2 AS THE "DIRECTORS
12	COUNCIL". THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL SHALL PROVIDE ADVICE, COUNSEL,
13	AND EXPERTISE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS CONCERNING THE STATE
14	HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S OPERATIONS AND ACCOMPLISHING ITS MISSION AND
15	OBJECTIVES. MEMBERS OF THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL ARE ELECTED BY THE
16	MEMBERS OF THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY PURSUANT TO NOMINATION
17	PROCEDURES ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.
18	(2) The board shall adopt bylaws for the directors
19	COUNCIL. THE BYLAWS MUST INCLUDE:
20	(a) THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL;
21	(b) The terms of office for members of the directors
22	COUNCIL; AND
23	(c) PROCEDURES WHEN THERE IS A VACANCY ON THE DIRECTORS
24	COUNCIL.
25	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
26	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
27	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
