Bill Summary

Legislative Audit Committee. Currently, the Colorado historical society (historical society) is governed by a board of directors (board) elected by members of the historical society. Under the bill, the method

of selecting the board is changed to a board appointed by the governor. The governor appoints 5 members with the consent of the senate. Four additional members are selected by the board and submitted to the governor for approval and appointment with the consent of the senate. Members appointed to the board have the authority to act on behalf of the board prior to confirmation by the senate. Terms of members of the board are 3 years, but initial terms are staggered.

There is also established a directors council (council) to advise the board. Members of the council are elected by members of the historical society. The board establishes the number of members of the council and their terms.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly

3 finds and declares that:

4 (a) The state historical society has been a Colorado nonprofit
5 corporation since its founding in 1879 and is presently a nonprofit
6 corporation under the "Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act",
7 articles 121 to 137 of title 7, C.R.S.

8 (b) The state historical society has also been an educational 9 institution of the state since 1915 and is a division of the department of 10 higher education, transferred by a type 1 transfer to the department of 11 higher education. Changing the method of selecting the board from a 12 board elected by the historical society's members to a board appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate will better balance the historical 13 14 society's needs as a nonprofit corporation with those of a state entity and 15 strengthen and enhance its relationship with the department of higher 16 education and the executive and legislative branches.

(c) The creation of a directors council is intended to provide the
board with advice, counsel, and expertise from others who are committed
to the historical society's educational mission.

(d) The provisions of this act are not intended to alter the state
historical society's status as a Colorado nonprofit corporation; except that
the provisions of this act relating to the selection, terms, and size of the
board of directors govern over any inconsistent provision in the
"Colorado Revised Nonprofit Corporation Act", the state historical
society's amended and restated articles, or its bylaws.

7 SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 24-80-201 as
8 follows:

9 24-80-201. Society an educational institution. The state 10 historical society, an incorporated organization, is hereby declared to be 11 one of the educational institutions of the state of Colorado. THE STATE 12 HISTORICAL SOCIETY EXERCISES ITS POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS 13 UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION AS IF IT WERE 14 TRANSFERRED TO THE DEPARTMENT BY A **TYPE 1** TRANSFER UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE "ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION ACT OF 1968", 15 16 ARTICLE 1 OF THIS TITLE.

SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-80-201.5 and
24-80-201.7 as follows:

19 24-80-201.5. State historical society - board - appointment 20 powers and duties - repeal. (1) EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015, THE BOARD OF
21 DIRECTORS OF THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY, REFERRED TO IN THIS PART
22 AS THE "BOARD" OR "BOARD OF DIRECTORS", CONSISTS OF NINE
23 MEMBERS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) (a) (I) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT, WITH THE CONSENT OF
THE SENATE, FIVE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD. THE GOVERNOR SHALL MAKE
THE INITIAL APPOINTMENTS ON OR BEFORE <u>JUNE 1</u>, 2015, TO BE EFFECTIVE
<u>JULY 1, 2015.</u> IF THERE IS A VACANCY OF A MEMBER APPOINTED PURSUANT

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TO THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I), THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A NEW
 MEMBER OF THE BOARD FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE UNEXPIRED TERM.

3 (II) (A) THE FOUR REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ARE 4 SELECTED BY THE BOARD FOR APPOINTMENT BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE 5 CONSENT OF THE SENATE. THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT THE NAME OR NAMES 6 OF PERSONS SELECTED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO THE GOVERNOR. 7 UPON APPOINTMENT BY THE GOVERNOR, THE NAME OF THE APPOINTEE IS 8 FORWARDED TO THE SENATE FOR CONFIRMATION. IF THE GOVERNOR DOES 9 NOT APPROVE OF A RECOMMENDATION FROM THE BOARD, THE GOVERNOR 10 SHALL NOTIFY THE BOARD OF HIS OR HER DECISION, AND THE BOARD 11 SHALL SUBMIT A NEW RECOMMENDATION. THE INITIAL APPOINTMENTS ARE 12 EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2015.

(B) FOR THE INITIAL SELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS, THE
MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS HOLDING ELECTIVE OFFICE AS OF
JUNE 1, 2015, SHALL SELECT FOUR PERSONS AND SUBMIT THEIR NAMES TO
THE GOVERNOR ON OR BEFORE JUNE 15, 2015, PURSUANT TO
SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II).

(C) IF THERE IS A VACANCY OR AT THE EXPIRATION OF THE TERM
OF A MEMBER APPOINTED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (II), THE
BOARD OF DIRECTORS SHALL SUBMIT A NAME OR NAMES TO THE
GOVERNOR PURSUANT TO SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS
SUBPARAGRAPH (II) FOR APPOINTMENT, REAPPOINTMENT, OR TO FILL AN
UNEXPIRED TERM.

(b) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS PARAGRAPH (b),
MEMBERS OF THE BOARD SERVE THREE-YEAR TERMS. THE MEMBERS FIRST
APPOINTED TO THE BOARD TAKE OFFICE ON <u>JULY 1, 2015.</u> OF THE
APPOINTMENTS OF MEMBERS TO TAKE OFFICE ON <u>JULY 1, 2015.</u> THE

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1 GOVERNOR SHALL DESIGNATE:

2 (I) THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO HAVE TERMS EXPIRING ON
 3 <u>JULY 1, 2016, INCLUDING ONE MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO</u>
 4 SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2);

5 (II) THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO HAVE TERMS EXPIRING ON
6 <u>JULY 1, 2017,</u> INCLUDING ONE MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED PURSUANT TO
7 SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2); AND

8 (III) THREE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD TO HAVE TERMS EXPIRING ON
9 JULY 1, 2018, INCLUDING TWO MEMBERS WHO ARE APPOINTED PURSUANT
10 TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF PARAGRAPH (a) OF THIS SUBSECTION (2).
11 THEREAFTER, THE TERMS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ARE THREE
12 YEARS.

(c) IN APPOINTING THE NINE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD, THE
GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT COLLECTIVELY THE MEMBERS POSSESS
<u>THE SKILLS IN STATE FINANCIAL, LEGAL, AND REGULATORY EXPERTISE AS</u>
<u>REQUIRED TO OVERSEE THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY AND</u> SHALL
CONSIDER BOTH GEOGRAPHIC AND CULTURAL DIVERSITY OF THE _____NINE
MEMBERS. THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT NO MORE THAN FIVE MEMBERS
FROM THE SAME POLITICAL PARTY.

20 (d) MEMBERS APPOINTED TO THE BOARD HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO
21 ACT ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD PRIOR TO OBTAINING CONFIRMATION BY
22 THE SENATE.

(3) THE BOARD APPOINTED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION
CONSTITUTES THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE STATE HISTORICAL
SOCIETY AND SHALL EXERCISE ALL OF THE POWERS, DUTIES AND
FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD AND THE HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INCLUDING
THOSE SET FORTH IN THIS PART 2 OR OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.

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(4) POLICIES, PROCEDURES, BYLAWS, RESOLUTIONS, AND
 AGREEMENTS APPROVED BY THE BOARD PRIOR TO <u>JULY 1, 2015</u>, REMAIN
 IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT UNLESS AND UNTIL CHANGED BY THE BOARD
 TAKING OFFICE <u>JULY 1, 2015</u>.

5 (5) (a) THE TERMS OF OFFICE OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE
BOARD HOLDING OFFICE PRIOR TO JULY 1, 2015, TERMINATE ON JUNE 30,
7 2015.

8 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (5) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016. 9 24-80-201.7. Directors council - creation - election - duties. 10 (1)THERE IS CREATED THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL OF THE STATE 11 HISTORICAL SOCIETY, REFERRED TO IN THIS PART 2 AS THE "DIRECTORS 12 COUNCIL". THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL SHALL PROVIDE ADVICE, COUNSEL, 13 AND EXPERTISE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS CONCERNING THE STATE 14 HISTORICAL SOCIETY'S OPERATIONS AND ACCOMPLISHING ITS MISSION AND 15 OBJECTIVES. MEMBERS OF THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL ARE ELECTED BY THE 16 MEMBERS OF THE STATE HISTORICAL SOCIETY PURSUANT TO NOMINATION 17 PROCEDURES ADOPTED BY THE BOARD.

18 (2) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT BYLAWS FOR THE DIRECTORS19 COUNCIL. THE BYLAWS MUST INCLUDE:

20 (a) THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF THE DIRECTORS COUNCIL;

(b) The terms of office for members of the directorscouncil; and

23 (c) PROCEDURES WHEN THERE IS A VACANCY ON THE DIRECTORS
24 COUNCIL.

25 <u>SECTION 4. Safety clause.</u> The general assembly hereby finds.
 26 <u>determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate</u>
 27 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
