1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **amend** 9-5.5-120 as
3 follows:

4 **9-5.5-120. Repeal of article.** This article is repealed, effective
5 July 1, ~~2017~~ 2022. Prior to ~~such~~ THE repeal, the functions of the
6 administrator ~~shall be~~ ARE subject to review pursuant to section
7 24-34-104, C.R.S.

8 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**
9 (48) (b); and **add** (53) as follows:

10 **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**
11 **and functions for termination, continuation, or reestablishment.**

12 (48) The following agencies, functions, or both, shall terminate on July
13 1, 2017:

14 (b) ~~The certification of conveyances and conveyance mechanics,~~
15 ~~contractors, and inspectors pursuant to article 5.5 of title 9, C.R.S.;~~

16 (53) THE FOLLOWING AGENCIES, FUNCTIONS, OR BOTH, TERMINATE
17 ON JULY 1, 2022:

18 (a) THE CERTIFICATION OF CONVEYANCES AND CONVEYANCE
19 MECHANICS, CONTRACTORS, AND INSPECTORS PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 5.5
20 OF TITLE 9, C.R.S.

21 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act
22 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
23 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
24 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, if a
25 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the

1 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
2 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
3 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
4 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
5 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
