# A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING MEASURES TO PROTECT OLDER COLORADANS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, ADDING ADDITIONAL PERSONS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO REPORT THE ABUSE OR EXPLOITATION OF SENIOR CITIZENS.

# **Bill Summary**

Current law lists a number of persons who are required to report to law enforcement the abuse or exploitation of a person 70 years of age or older. The bill adds additional persons to the list.
