A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE NUMBER OF DISABLED VETERAN LICENSE PLATES  
102 WITH THE IDENTIFYING FIGURE AUTHORIZING THE USE OF  
103 PARKING PRIVILEGES THAT MAY BE ISSUED TO A QUALIFIED  
104 INDIVIDUAL.

Bill Summary

Currently, a qualified person may be issued only one disabled veteran license plate with the figure that authorizes the use of parking privileges, and the person may be issued a parking placard. The bill

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-204, **amend** (3)

3 (b) (II) as follows:

4 **42-3-204. Reserved parking for persons with disabilities -**  
5 **applicability - definitions - rules. (3) Types of plates or placards.**

6 (b) **Number of placards and license plates allowed.** (II) The  
7 department may issue TWO DISABLED VETERAN LICENSE PLATES WITH  
8 IDENTIFYING FIGURES OR a disabled veteran license plate with an  
9 additional identifying figure and one placard to ~~an~~ A QUALIFIED  
10 individual.

11 **SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
12 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
13 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August  
14 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, if a  
15 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the  
16 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act  
17 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect  
18 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
19 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
20 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
