Bill Summary

Currently, a qualified person may be issued only one disabled veteran license plate with the figure that authorizes the use of parking

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privileges, and the person may be issued a parking placard. The bill allows a person the option to be issued 2 of these license plates.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-3-204, amend (3) 3 (b) (II) as follows: 4 42-3-204. Reserved parking for persons with disabilities -5 applicability - definitions - rules. (3) Types of plates or placards. 6 Number of placards and license plates allowed. (II) (b) The 7 department may issue TWO DISABLED VETERAN LICENSE PLATES WITH 8 IDENTIFYING FIGURES OR a disabled veteran license plate with an 9 additional identifying figure and one placard to an A QUALIFIED 10 individual. 11 SECTION 2. Appropriation. For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, 12 \$7,880 is appropriated to the department of revenue for use by the 13 division of motor vehicles. This appropriation consists of \$2,866 from the 14 general fund and \$5,014 from the license plate cash fund created in 15 section 42-3-301 (1) (b), C.R.S. To implement this act, the division may 16 use this appropriation for license plate ordering. 17 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 18 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 20 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6, 2015); except that, if a 21 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 22 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 23 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect

24 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in

- 1 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
- 2 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
