## **Bill Summary**

The bill makes appropriations for matters related to the legislative department for the 2015-16 state fiscal year. The bill makes an appropriation to the youth advisory council cash fund.

| 18 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> Appropriation. For the 2015-16 state fiscal year,          |
| 19 | \$25,000 is appropriated to the youth advisory council cash fund created     |
| 20 | in section 2-2-1306, C.R.S. This appropriation is from the general fund.     |
| 21 | The legislative department is responsible for the accounting related to this |
| 22 | appropriation.   |
| 23 | SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,                 |
| 24 | determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate        |
| 25 | preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.                        |

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
