A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING STATE ENGINEER ADMINISTRATION OF TAILWATER DITCHES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill permits a person to use a tail ditch to return variable amounts of water to a stream. The state engineer shall not require the delivery of a minimum amount of water to the stream, except as required by a court decree.

3	SECTION <u>1.</u> In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 37-84-108 as
4	follows:
5	37-84-108. Running excess of water forbidden. (1) During the
6	summer season it shall not be lawful for any A person to SHALL NOT run
7	through his OR HER irrigating ditch any greater quantity of water than is
8	absolutely necessary for irrigating, his land and for domestic, and stock
9	purposes it being the intent and meaning of this section to prevent the
10	wasting and useless discharge and running away of water.
11	(2) A PERSON USING AN IRRIGATING DITCH OR DITCH SYSTEM MAY
12	USE A TAIL DITCH TO RETURN WATER TO THE STREAM IN VARIABLE
13	AMOUNTS AS NECESSARY TO FACILITATE EFFICIENT OPERATION OF THE
14	DITCH AND DELIVERY OF WATER TO PERSONS SERVED BY THE DITCH OR
15	DITCH SYSTEM. THE STATE ENGINEER SHALL NOT REQUIRE THE DELIVERY
16	OF ANY MINIMUM AMOUNT OF $\underline{\text{SUCH}}$ WATER, EXCEPT AS REQUIRED BY
17	COURT DECREE. NOTHING IN THIS SECTION LIMITS THE STATE ENGINEER'S
18	AUTHORITY TO ADMINISTER WATER RIGHTS TO PREVENT WASTE.
19	SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date -
20	applicability. (1) This act takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following
21	the expiration of the ninety-day period after final adjournment of the
22	general assembly (August 5, 2015, if adjournment sine die is on May 6,
23	2015); except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1
24	(3) of article V of the state constitution against this act or an item, section,
25	or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part
26	will not take effect unless approved by the people at the general election
27	to be held in November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the

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- date of the official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
- 2 (2) This act applies to conduct occurring on or after the applicable
- 3 effective date of this act.

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
