Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. The bill requires the state treasurer to transfer \$2,059,079 from the intellectual and developmental disabilities services cash fund to the general fund on April 1, 2015.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 25.5-10-207, add (6)
3	as follows:
4	25.5-10-207. Services and supports - waiting list reduction -
5	cash fund - repeal. (6) (a) On April 1, 2015, the state treasurer
6	SHALL TRANSFER TWO MILLION FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SEVENTY-NINE
7	DOLLARS FROM THE INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
8	SERVICES CASH FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.
9	(b) This subsection (6) is repealed, effective July 1, 2016.
10	SECTION 2. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds.
11	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
12	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
