20 expenditures is decreased by \$30,026.

21 (2) For the 2015-16 state fiscal year, the general assembly
22 anticipates that the department of health care policy and financing will
23 receive \$2,293,982 in federal funds for medical services premiums. The
24 appropriation in subsection (1) of this section is based on the assumption
25 that the department will receive this amount of federal funds."
