

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1266**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill allows the department of revenue to seize and destroy medical and retail marijuana that testing shows contains harmful contaminants, as determined by *rules promulgated* by the department of public health and environment, or unauthorized pesticides. *The marijuana establishment can request a hearing to contest the results of the test. The bill appropriates \$23,753 from the marijuana cash fund for the department of law's provision of legal services to the department of revenue in connection with implementation of the act.*
