

**UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 16-051**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Under current law, for a person convicted of 2 or more separate crimes of violence arising out of the same incident, the court must require the person to serve the resulting sentences consecutively rather than concurrently. The bill ~~removes this requirement~~ *states that the court has discretion to require the person to serve the resulting sentences consecutively rather than concurrently if one of the crimes is aggravated robbery, assault in the second degree, or escape.*
