

UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1436

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

The bill requires the state marijuana licensing authority to promulgate rules that prohibit the production and sale of edible marijuana products that ~~resemble the form~~ *are in the distinct shape* of a human, animal, or fruit. *Geometric shapes and products that are simply fruit flavored are not considered fruit. Products in the shape of a marijuana leaf are permissible. The prohibition does not apply to a company logo. The promulgated rules take effect October 1, 2017.*
