

**UPDATED SUMMARY
HOUSE BILL 16-1039**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Transportation Legislation Review Committee. Currently, a person is required to use certain traction control equipment, such as chains or snow-rated tires, when the Colorado department of transportation restricts road use due to a winter storm. The bill broadens this law to require the traction equipment to be carried on I-70 between milepost 133 (Dotsero) and milepost 259 (Morrison) ~~when icy or snow-packed conditions are present~~ *between October 1 to May 15 of each year.* The bill also requires that this traction control equipment be used when icy or snowy conditions are present.
