

**UPDATED SUMMARY
SENATE BILL 16-039**

Second Regular Session - Seventieth Colorado General Assembly

This summary applies to the reengrossed version of this bill as introduced in the second house. It does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. This summary reflects only the main points of the legislation.

Legislative Oversight Committee Concerning the Treatment of Persons With Mental Illness in the Criminal and Juvenile Justice Systems. The bill adds a mental health professional, *if an area does not have a community mental health center*, to the list of persons to be included in any memorandum of understanding entered into between interested county departments of social or human services and other local-level service providers when the memorandum of understanding is established as a means of promoting a collaborative system of local-level interagency oversight and services to children and families. *The bill also allows the parent or parents of the child involved to participate in meetings of the local-level interagency oversight groups established through the memorandum of understanding.*
