Bill Summary

Joint Budget Committee. Currently, the maximum amount of the year-end uncommitted reserves in the department of state cash fund is equal to 16.5% of the amount expended from the cash fund during the fiscal year. The bill establishes an alternative maximum reserve for the fund that increases the existing maximum reserve by an amount equal to the amount of unexpended money from an appropriation to the







department of state to reimburse county clerks and recorders for election costs.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-21-104, add (4) 3 as follows: 4 24-21-104. Fees of secretary of state. (4) FOR FISCAL YEARS 5 BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2015, AND FOR PURPOSES OF SECTION 6 24-75-402, THE ALTERNATIVE MAXIMUM RESERVE FOR THE DEPARTMENT 7 OF STATE CASH FUND IS EQUAL TO SIXTEEN AND FIVE-TENTHS PERCENT OF 8 THE TOTAL AMOUNT THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE EXPENDED FROM THE 9 FUND DURING THE FISCAL YEAR, PLUS AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT 10 OF UNEXPENDED MONEY FROM AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT 11 OF STATE FROM THE FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR TO REIMBURSE COUNTY 12 CLERKS AND RECORDERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 24-21-104.5 FOR 13 ELECTION COSTS. 14 **SECTION 2.** Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 15 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

16 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
