BILL TOPIC: UTE REPRESENTATIVES FOR TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Summary of Legislation

The bill alters the membership of the Statewide Transportation Advisory Committee (STAC) to include as full-fledged, voting members one representative from the Southern Ute Tribe and one representative from the Ute Mountain Ute Tribe.

Background

The STAC provides advice to the Colorado Department of Transportation on transportation system needs, and reviews and comments on all regional transportation plans. There is currently one Southern Ute Tribe and one Ute Mountain Ute Tribe representative serving on the STAC; however, these representatives are non-voting members. All STAC members, regardless of their voting status, receive expense reimbursement for their work on the STAC.

Assessment

The bill does not change the revenue or expenditures for any agency of state or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 10, 2016, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 11, 2016, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed.
