J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision that makes the General Fund appropriations indicated in the following table to the Office of the Governor and the Legislative Department for FY 2016-17. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Departments will require the additional FTE indicated in the table to implement the act.

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2016-17 based on the March 2016 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package allocates \$3.0 million General Fund to be available to fund 2016 legislation that is not accounted for in the budget package. If the full \$3.0 million is not used to fund legislation, it will remain in the General Fund reserve.
