# A BILL FOR AN ACT

#### 101 **CONCERNING THE USE OF AN OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLE TO CROSS STATE**

102 HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF A MUNICIPALITY.

#### **Bill Summary**

Currently, a person may cross a state highway with an off-highway vehicle except within the jurisdiction of a municipality. The bill grants municipalities the authority to allow off-highway vehicles to cross a state highway.

**SENATE BILL 16-008** 

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-108.5, 3 **amend** (1) as follows: 4 33-14.5-108.5. Crossing roads, highways, and railroad tracks. 5 (1) The driver of an off-highway vehicle may directly cross a roadway, including a state highway, at an at-grade crossing to continue using the 6 7 off-highway vehicle on the other side. except that a person shall not cross 8 a state highway within the jurisdiction of a municipality. 9 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 33-14.5-110, add (3) 10 as follows: 11 33-14.5-110. Regulation by political subdivisions. (3) FOR A 12 CITY OR TOWN TO REGULATE THE CROSSING OF A STATE HIGHWAY UNDER 13 THE JURISDICTION OF THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, 14 THE CITY OR TOWN MUST REQUEST IN WRITING THAT THE REGIONAL OFFICE 15 OF THE DEPARTMENT APPROVE THE REGULATION. THE REGIONAL OFFICE 16 SHALL NOT UNREASONABLY WITHHOLD APPROVAL. IF THE REGIONAL 17 OFFICE DOES NOT APPROVE OR DENY THE REQUEST WITHIN SIXTY DAYS 18 AFTER RECEIVED, THE REQUEST IS DEEMED APPROVED. 19 SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds, 20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate

21 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
