1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 31-31-708 as
3 follows:

4 **31-31-708.** Optional affiliation by county sheriff. ANY COUNTY 5 THAT DOES NOT COVER, UNDER THE FEDERAL "SOCIAL SECURITY ACT", AS 6 AMENDED, SALARIED EMPLOYEES WHOSE DUTIES ARE DIRECTLY INVOLVED 7 WITH THE PROVISION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OR FIRE PROTECTION AS 8 CERTIFIED BY THE COUNTY MAY ELECT COVERAGE UNDER THE STATEWIDE 9 DEFINED BENEFIT PLAN ESTABLISHED IN PART 4 OF THIS ARTICLE AND THE 10 STATEWIDE DEATH AND DISABILITY PLAN ESTABLISHED IN PART 8 OF THIS 11 ARTICLE BY FILING A RESOLUTION OF AFFILIATION WITH THE BOARD. 12 ELECTION OF COVERAGE UNDER THE PLAN IS IRREVOCABLE.

13 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 16 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a 17 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 18 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 19 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 20 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 21 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 22 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
