A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING CLARIFYING THE TYPES OF TRANSACTIONS THAT MAY BE

102 INCLUDED IN A MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE CONTRACT.

Bill Summary

The bill authorizes the following products or services to be offered in connection with a motor vehicle service contract:

- ! Repair or replacement of wheels or tires damaged by road hazards;
- ! Paintless dent repair;
- ! Repair or replacement of a windshield damaged by road

hazards;

- ! Replacement of a key or key fob that is broken, lost, or stolen; and
- ! Other services approved by the commissioner of insurance.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

- 2 SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-11-101, amend
 3 (3); and add (5.5) as follows:
- 4 42-11-101. Definitions. As used in this article, unless the context
 5 otherwise requires:

6 (3) (a) "Motor vehicle service contract" or "service contract" 7 means a contract or agreement between a provider and a service contract 8 holder, WHICH CONTRACT OR AGREEMENT IS given for consideration over 9 and above the lease or purchase price of a motor vehicle that undertakes 10 AND OBLIGATES THE PROVIDER to perform or provide repair or 11 replacement service, or indemnification for that service, for the 12 operational or structural failure of a motor vehicle due to a defect in 13 materials or skill of work or normal wear and tear. but A MOTOR VEHICLE 14 SERVICE CONTRACT MAY PROVIDE FOR ANY ONE OR MORE OF THE 15 FOLLOWING SERVICES:

16 (I) REPAIRING OR REPLACING TIRES OR WHEELS ON A MOTOR
17 VEHICLE DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF COMING INTO CONTACT WITH ROAD
18 HAZARDS;

(II) REMOVING DENTS, DINGS, OR CREASES ON A MOTOR VEHICLE
THAT CAN BE REPAIRED USING THE PROCESS OF PAINTLESS DENT REMOVAL
WITHOUT AFFECTING THE EXISTING PAINT FINISH AND WITHOUT REPLACING
VEHICLE BODY PANELS, SANDING, BONDING, OR PAINTING;

23 (III) REPLACING OR REPAIRING A WINDSHIELD DAMAGED BY ROAD

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1 HAZARDS;

2 (IV) REPLACING A MOTOR VEHICLE KEY OR KEY FOB IF THE KEY OR
3 KEY FOB BECOMES INOPERABLE OR IS LOST OR STOLEN;

4 (V) OTHER SERVICES, WHICH MAY BE APPROVED BY THE
5 COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE IF CONSISTENT WITH OTHER PROVISIONS OF
6 THIS ARTICLE.

7 (b) "MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE CONTRACT" OR "SERVICE
8 CONTRACT" does not include mechanical breakdown insurance.

9 (5.5) "ROAD HAZARD" MEANS A HAZARD THAT IS ENCOUNTERED
10 WHILE DRIVING A MOTOR VEHICLE. "ROAD HAZARD" MAY INCLUDE
11 POTHOLES, ROCKS, WOOD DEBRIS, METAL PARTS, GLASS, PLASTIC, CURBS,
12 OR COMPOSITE SCRAPS.

13 SECTION 2. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 16 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a 17 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 18 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 19 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 20 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 21 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 22 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
