A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING THE ALLOWABLE FINANCE CHARGE FOR CERTAIN CONSUMER CREDIT TRANSACTIONS.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Current law limits the permissible finance charge on certain supervised loans and consumer credit sales based on the unpaid balances of the amounts financed. The amounts financed were established in statute in 2000.

The bill requires the administrator to make an initial adjustment of the amounts financed for inflation and then continue to adjust the SENATE rd Reading Unamended April 27, 2016

Finance charge for consumer credit transactions. 5 (9) Not later than January 1, 2017, the administrator shall 6 ADJUST THE DOLLAR AMOUNTS IN PARAGRAPH (a) OF SUBSECTION (2) OF 7 THIS SECTION TO ACCOUNT FOR INFLATION FROM 2000 TO 2017 AND SHALL 8 ANNUALLY ADJUST FOR INFLATION EACH JANUARY 1 THEREAFTER. THE 9 ADMINISTRATOR SHALL MAKE THE ADJUSTMENTS BASED ON THE 10 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR THE DENVER-BOULDER-GREELEY 11 METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA. 12 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 13 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 14 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 15 10, 2016, if adjournment sine die is on May 11, 2016); except that, if a 16 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 17 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 18 19 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 20 November 2016 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 21 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
