Resolution Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this resolution as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Beginning with the state fiscal year 2017-18, the distribution of the state lottery proceeds is changed as follows:

- ! The percentage of proceeds distributed to the conservation trust fund is decreased from 40% to 30%;
- ! The percentage of proceeds distributed to the great outdoors Colorado trust fund, which is subject to annual cap, is decreased from 50% to 35%; and
- ! 25% of the proceeds is distributed to the state education fund.

1 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventieth 2 *General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:* 3 **SECTION 1.** At the election held on November 8, 2016, the 4 secretary of state shall submit to the registered electors of the state the 5 ballot title set forth in section 2 for the following amendment to the state 6 constitution: 7 In the constitution of the state of Colorado, section 3 of article 8 XXVII, amend (1) (b) introductory portion; and add (1) (f) as follows: 9 **Section 3. Moneys allocated to Trust Fund.** (1) Beginning with 10 the proceeds from the fourth quarter of the State's Fiscal Year 1992-1993, 11 all proceeds from all programs, including Lotto and every other 12 state-supervised lottery game operated under the authority of Article 13 XVIII, Section 2 of the Colorado Constitution, whether by the Colorado 14 Lottery Commission or otherwise (such programs defined hereafter in this 15 Article as "Lottery Programs"), net of prizes and expenses of the state 16 lottery division and after a sufficient amount of money has been reserved, 17 as of the end of any fiscal quarter, to ensure the operation of the lottery 18 for the ensuing fiscal quarter (such netted proceeds defined hereafter in 19 this Article as "Net Proceeds") are set aside, allocated, allotted, and 20 continuously appropriated as follows, and the Treasurer shall distribute

7	(I) THIRTY PERCENT TO THE CONSERVATION TRUST FUND FOR
8	DISTRIBUTION TO MUNICIPALITIES AND COUNTIES AND OTHER ELIGIBLE
9	ENTITIES FOR PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACE PURPOSES;
10	(II) TEN PERCENT TO THE DIVISION OF PARKS AND OUTDOOR
11	RECREATION FOR THE ACQUISITION, DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT OF
12	NEW AND EXISTING STATE PARKS, RECREATION AREAS AND RECREATIONAL
13	TRAILS;
14	(III) TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT TO THE STATE EDUCATION FUND
15	CREATED IN SECTION 17 OF ARTICLE IX OF THIS CONSTITUTION; AND
16	(IV) ALL REMAINING NET PROCEEDS IN TRUST TO THE BOARD OF
17	THE TRUST FUND, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT IN ANY STATE FISCAL YEAR
18	IN WHICH THE PORTION OF THE NET PROCEEDS WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE
19	BE GIVEN IN TRUST TO THE STATE BOARD OF THE TRUST FUND EXCEEDS
20	THE AMOUNT OF \$35 MILLION, TO BE ADJUSTED EACH YEAR FOR CHANGES
21	FROM THE 1992 CONSUMER PRICE INDEX-DENVER, THE NET PROCEEDS IN
22	EXCESS OF SUCH AMOUNT OR ADJUSTED AMOUNT SHALL BE ALLOCATED TO
23	THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE OF COLORADO.
24	In the constitution of the state of Colorado, section 17 of article
25	IX, amend (4) (a) as follows:
26	Section 17. Education - Funding. (4) State Education Fund
27	Created. (a) There is hereby created in the department of the treasury the

state education fund. Beginning on the effective date of this measure, all state revenues collected from a tax of one third of one percent on federal taxable income, as modified by law, of every individual, estate, trust and corporation, as defined in law, shall be deposited in the state education fund. IN ADDITION, A PORTION OF STATE LOTTERY NET PROCEEDS SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE STATE EDUCATION FUND AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 3 (1) (f) (III) OF ARTICLE XXVII OF THIS CONSTITUTION. Revenues generated from a tax of one third of one percent on federal taxable income, as modified by law, of every individual, estate, trust and corporation, as defined in law, shall not be subject to the limitation on fiscal year spending set forth in article X, section 20 of the Colorado constitution. All interest earned on monies in the state education fund shall be deposited in the state education fund and shall be used before any principal is depleted. Monies remaining in the state education fund at the end of any fiscal year shall remain in the fund and not revert to the general fund.

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SECTION 2. Each elector voting at the election may cast a vote either "Yes/For" or "No/Against" on the following ballot title: "Shall there be an amendment to the Colorado constitution concerning the distribution of state lottery net proceeds, and, in connection therewith, decreasing the distributions to the conservation trust fund and the great outdoors Colorado trust fund and creating a new distribution to the state education fund?"

SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided in section 1-40-123, Colorado Revised Statutes, if a majority of the electors voting on the ballot title vote "Yes/For", then the amendment will become part of the state constitution.
