Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB04-1034 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend engrossed bill, page 3, strike lines 6 through 20.

2 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.

3 Page 3, after line 22, insert the following:

4 "(I) SUBMIT TO THE COMMISSION ON INFORMATION AND
5 TECHNOLOGY WITHIN THE OFFICE OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY
6 CREATED IN THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR FOR THE COMMISSION'S REVIEW
7 AND APPROVAL THE DEPARTMENT'S PLAN FOR THE RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S
8 LICENSE BY ELECTRONIC MEANS."

9 Renumber succeeding subparagraphs accordingly.

10 Page 5, line 1, strike "(e)" and substitute "(d)";

11 line 7, strike "THE STATEWIDE INTERNET PORTAL OR" and substitute "THE
12 RENEWAL OF A DRIVER'S LICENSE BY ELECTRONIC MEANS, ANTICIPATED
13 EXPENSES AND COSTS OF IMPLEMENTING THIS RENEWAL PROCESS
14 INCLUDING ANTICIPATED FUNDING REQUESTS ASSOCIATED WITH THESE
15 EXPENSES AND COSTS, WORLD WIDE WEB APPLICATIONS, AND MEASURES

1 THE DEPARTMENT WILL IMPLEMENT TO MINIMIZE POSSIBLE OPPORTUNITIES
2 FOR IDENTITY THEFT AND FRAUD.";

3 strike lines 8 through 24 and substitute the following:

4 "(g) THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE ANY NECESSARY RULES
5 FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SUBSECTION (1.5).

6 **SECTION 2. Applicability.** This act shall apply to drivers'
7 licenses renewed on or after the effective date of this act.

8 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
9 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
10 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety."
