Committee on Appropriations.

After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB04-189 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 8, strike lines 16 through 26.
- 2 Renumber succeeding subsections accordingly.
- 3 Page 16, after line 26, insert the following:
  - 4 "(c) IF AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IS DESIGNATED AS
  - 5 AN ENTERPRISE PURSUANT TO SECTION 23-5-101.7, THE INSTITUTION
  - 6 SHALL ANNUALLY ALLOCATE AT LEAST TWENTY PERCENT OF ANY
  - 7 INCREASE IN TUITION REVENUES ABOVE INFLATION TO NEED-BASED
  - 8 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE."
- 9 Page 17, line 4, after "REDUCTION", insert "DURING THE SAME FISCAL
- 10 YEAR".
- 11 Page 27, strike line 3 and substitute the following:
  - 12 "(c)";
  - 13 line 4, strike "SHALL" and substitute "SHALL";

1 strike line 6 and substitute the following:

2 "FOR THE COMMISSION TO FORWARD TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY DURING  
3 THE ANNUAL BUDGET PROCESS."

4 Page 28, line 13, strike "23-18-102 (5)." and substitute "23-18-102 (3).";

5 line 15, strike "23-18-102 (6)." and substitute "23-18-102 (4).";

6 line 17, strike "23-18-102 (12)." and substitute "23-18-102 (10).".

7 Page 29, line 20, strike "(1) THE" and substitute "(1) BEGINNING JULY  
8 1, 2005, THE".

9 Page 40, line 1, strike "(1.5) and (2)" and substitute "(1.5), (2), and (6)";

10 strike lines 3 and 4 and substitute the following:

11 **"SECTION 14. Appropriations in long bill to be adjusted.**

12 (1) For the implementation of this act, appropriations made in the annual  
13 general appropriation act to the department of higher education,  
14 governing boards and local district junior colleges, regents of the  
15 university of Colorado, governing board and general campuses, general  
16 fund and tuition allocation, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004,  
17 shall be adjusted as follows:

18 (a) The general fund appropriation shall be reduced by four  
19 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$4,500,000).

20 (b) The cash funds appropriation shall be increased by four  
21 million five hundred thousand dollars (\$4,500,000). Said sum shall be  
22 from tuition.

23 **SECTION 15. Effective date.** (1) Except as provided in  
24 subsections (2) and (3) of this section, this act shall take effect July 1,  
25 2004.

26 (2) Sections 5, 7, and 13 of this act shall take effect July 1, 2005.

1 (3) Section 14 of this act shall take effect only if:

2 (a) During state fiscal year 2004-05, the board of regents of the  
3 university of Colorado designates the university of Colorado as an  
4 enterprise pursuant to section 23-5-101.7, Colorado Revised Statutes; and

5 (b) The board of regents of the university of Colorado files  
6 written notice with the revisor of statutes and the staff director of the joint  
7 budget committee of the enterprise designation specified in paragraph (a)  
8 of this subsection (3)."

9 Renumber succeeding section accordingly.

10 Page 1, line 101, strike "**EDUCATION.**" and substitute "**EDUCATION, AND**  
11 **MAKING AN APPROPRIATION IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.**".
