After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

SB04-046 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 5, strike "IN A CASE";
- 2 strike line 6 through 18 and substitute the following:
 - 3 "IN A CRIMINAL PROSECUTION INCLUDING AN OFFENSE DESCRIBED IN
 - 4 SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION, THE COURT MAY, AT ANY TIME UPON
 - 5 MOTION OF THE PROSECUTION OR ON THE COURT'S OWN MOTION, ISSUE A
 - 6 PROTECTIVE ORDER PURSUANT TO THE COLORADO RULES OF CRIMINAL
 - 7 PROCEDURE CONCERNING DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION RELATING TO THE
 - 8 VICTIM OR A WITNESS. THE COURT MAY PUNISH A VIOLATION OF A
 - 9 PROTECTIVE ORDER BY CONTEMPT OF COURT.
- 10 (b) THE VICTIM WHO WOULD BE THE SUBJECT OF THE PROTECTIVE
- 11 ORDER MAY OBJECT TO THE MOTION FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER."
