After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB04-1030 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 13, strike "WELFARE OVERSIGHT" and
- 2 substitute "HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT, WELFARE, AND INSTITUTIONS";
- 3 line 14, strike "COMMITTEE" and substitute "COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE
- 4 OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE".
- 5 Page 4, strike lines 6 through 9.
- 6 Reletter succeeding paragraphs accordingly.
- 7 Page 4, line 16, strike "JULY", and substitute "AUGUST";
- 8 line 19, strike "AUGUST 31", and substitute "SEPTEMBER 30".
- 9 Page 5, line 25, strike "CHAIRPERSON" and substitute "CHAIRPERSONS";
- 10 strike lines 26 and 27 and substitute the following:
- 11 "THE HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT, WELFARE, AND INSTITUTIONS COMMITTEES
- 12 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE. THE CHAIRPERSONS
- 13 OF THE HEALTH, ENVIRONMENT, WELFARE, AND INSTITUTIONS COMMITTEES

1 OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE, OR THE
2 CHAIRPERSONS' DESIGNEE,".

3 Page 6, line 1, strike "ANEX-OFFICIO MEMBER" and substitute "EX-OFFICIO
4 MEMBERS";

5 strike lines 15 through 17 and substitute the following:

6 **"SECTION 4. Effective date.** This act shall take effect at 12:01
7 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after
8 final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting
9 a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state
10 constitution (August 4, 2004, if adjournment sine die is on May 5, 2004);
11 except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an item,
12 section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, section,
13 or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of the
14 official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the governor.".
