A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING AUTHORIZATION OF CERTAIN FAMILY MEMBERS OF A**
102 **PERSON WHO HAS DIED SERVING IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED**
103 **FORCES TO BE ISSUED MILITARY LICENSE PLATES.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Authorizes the spouse, child, or parent of a person who has died serving in the armed forces to be issued any military special license plate for which the deceased would have qualified.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1.** 42-3-115.5 (1), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
2 amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW PARAGRAPH to read:

3 **42-3-115.5. Special plates - military veterans - rules -**
4 **retirement.** (1) (g) THE SPOUSE, CHILD, OR PARENT OF A PERSON WHO
5 HAS DIED WHILE SERVING IN THE ARMED FORCES IS AUTHORIZED TO BE
6 ISSUED ANY MILITARY SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE THE DECEASED WOULD
7 HAVE QUALIFIED FOR UNDER THIS ARTICLE OR A RULE PROMULGATED BY
8 THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

9 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
