After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB05-1028 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 2, line 9, strike "FORCES." and substitute
2 "FORCES AND DEPLOYED TO A COMBAT ZONE.";

3 line 14, after "FORCES", insert "AND DEPLOYED TO A COMBAT ZONE";

4 line 20, after the period, add "THIS PARAGRAPH (g) SHALL NOT BE
5 CONSTRUED TO AUTHORIZE THE SPOUSE, CHILD, OR PARENT TO RECEIVE A
6 SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE IF SUCH PLATE SIGNIFIES MORE THAN THAT THE
7 DECEASED SERVED IN A BRANCH OF THE ARMED FORCES.".

8 Page 3, after line 13, insert the following:

9 "SECTION 4. 42-1-102 (24.5), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
10 amended to read:

11 **42-1-102. Definitions - repeal.** As used in articles 1 to 4 of this
12 title, unless the context otherwise requires:

13 (24.5) "Distinctive special license plate" means a special license
14 plate that is issued to a person because such person has an immutable
15 characteristic or special achievement honor. Such special achievement
16 honor shall not include a common achievement such as graduating from
17 an institution of higher education. DISTINCTIVE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE
18 SHALL INCLUDE A LICENSE PLATE THAT IS ISSUED TO A PERSON OR THE
19 PERSON'S FAMILY TO HONOR SUCH PERSON'S SERVICE IN THE ARMED

- 1 FORCES."
- 2 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
