A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING THE CREATION OF AN INCENTIVE TO RECRUIT**
102 **ENLISTMENTS FOR THE NATIONAL GUARD.**

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Specifies that eligible persons who recruit new enlistments for the army national guard or air national guard may receive a \$200 recruiting bonus for each new enlistment recruited. Clarifies that the bonus is subject to available appropriations.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

1 **SECTION 1.** Part 4 of article 3 of title 28, Colorado Revised
2 Statutes, is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to
3 read:

4 **28-3-401.5. Recruiting incentive.** (1) A MEMBER OF THE ARMY
5 NATIONAL GUARD OR AIR NATIONAL GUARD, NOT ASSIGNED TO A
6 RECRUITING-RETENTION POSITION, WHO RECRUITS A NEW ENLISTED
7 MEMBER OF THE ARMY NATIONAL GUARD OR AIR NATIONAL GUARD AND
8 WHO MEETS THE RECRUITING BONUS ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS SET
9 FORTH IN THE REGULATION PRESCRIBED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF
10 THIS SECTION MAY, SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS, RECEIVE A
11 RECRUITING BONUS OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR EACH NEW
12 ENLISTMENT RECRUITED.

13 (2) THE ADJUTANT GENERAL SHALL PRESCRIBE A REGULATION
14 SPECIFYING THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES FOR
15 RECEIVING A RECRUITING BONUS PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

16 **SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability.** This act shall take
17 effect July 1, 2005, and shall apply to new enlistments recruited on or
18 after said date.

19 **SECTION 3. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
20 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
21 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
