**TITLE:** CONCERNING RULES OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE ESTABLISHING A SYSTEM FOR ELECTRONICALLY TRANSMITTING NOTARIZED, AUTHENTICATED PHOTOGRAPHS OF INDIVIDUALS.

**Summary of Assessment**

This bill requires the Secretary of State, as soon as feasible, to adopt rules to establish standards, procedures, practices, forms, and records relating to the ability of notaries public to transmit encrypted, authenticated photographs of individuals for use by motor vehicle offices, credit card companies, and other entities requiring authenticated photographs. The rules shall authorize the notary to charge a fee of no more than \$10 for each photograph electronically transmitted. The bill will become effective August 10, 2005, unless a referendum petition is filed.

The Secretary of State will be able to adopt and administer these rules within existing budgetary resources. The bill will not affect state or local government revenue or expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
