A BILL FOR AN ACT

CONCERNING A REQUIREMENT THAT CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE
APPLICATIONS MADE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE
CONTAIN THE APPLICANT'S PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Requires applications for registration of a motor vehicle and applications for filing of a certificate of title to a motor vehicle to contain the applicant's personal identification number as provided on a state-issued driver's license or assigned by the department of revenue.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

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2 **SECTION 1.** 42-3-105 (1) (a), Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

42-3-105. Application for registration - tax. (1) (a) Application for the registration of a vehicle required to be registered under this article shall be made by the owner or the owner's agent and, if applicable, simultaneously with the application for certificate of title, as required by this section. The application for registration, which shall be in writing and signed by the owner of such THE vehicle or the owner's duly authorized agent, shall include: The name of the applicant; the name and correct address of the owner determined pursuant to section 42-6-139, designating the county, school district, and city or town within the limits of which the owner resides; a description of the motor vehicle in such A form as shall be required by the department; the purpose for which the vehicle is used; whether the vehicle is a commercial vehicle; the notice described in subsection (2) of this section; whether the applicant requests that the department should, if it approves the application, mail to the owner the license plate required under this article; and such ANY other pertinent information as may be required by the department, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE OWNER'S OR REGISTRANT'S PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER AS PROVIDED ON A STATE-ISSUED DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ASSIGNED BY THE DEPARTMENT. In addition, on or after July 1, 1999, any application for new registration of a vehicle shall include the primary body color of the motor vehicle. On and after July 1, 2003, any application submitted in person to a county clerk and recorder, the manager of revenue or such ANY other official of the city and county of Denver as may be appointed by the mayor to perform functions related

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to the registration of motor vehicles, or department office for registration of a motor vehicle that has been previously registered shall include the primary body color of the motor vehicle.

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SECTION 2. 42-6-116, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended to read:

42-6-116. Applications for filing of certificates of title. In any case Whenever, under the provisions of this part 1, wherein a person who desires or who is entitled to a filing of a certificate of title to a motor vehicle is required to make formal application to the director or the director's authorized agent, therefor, such THE applicant shall make application upon a form provided by the director. in which appears THE APPLICATION SHALL INCLUDE a description of the motor vehicle, including the make and model, the manufacturer's number, the date on which said THE motor vehicle was first sold by the dealer or manufacturer of the motor vehicle to the initial user of the motor vehicle, and a description of any other distinguishing mark, number, or symbol placed on said THE vehicle by the vehicle manufacturer for identification purposes, as may by rule be required by the director Such BY RULE ADOPTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 4 OF TITLE 24, C.R.S. THE application shall also show the name and correct address of the owner determined pursuant to section 42-6-139, THE OWNER'S PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER AS PROVIDED ON A STATE-ISSUED DRIVER'S LICENSE OR ASSIGNED BY THE DEPARTMENT, and the applicant's source of title and shall include a description of all known mortgages and liens upon said THE motor vehicle, each including the name of the legal holder thereof, the amount originally secured, the amount outstanding on the obligation secured at the time such THE application is made, and the name of the county OR city

2	recorded or filed. Such THE application shall be verified by a statement
3	signed by the applicant and shall contain or be accompanied by a written
4	declaration that it is made under the penalties of perjury in the second
5	degree, as defined in section 18-8-503, C.R.S.
6	SECTION 3. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take
7	effect January 1, 2007, and shall apply to applications made on or after
8	said date.
9	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds.
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.

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
