After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB06-1007 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend reengrossed bill, page 4, line 6, strike "TRANSFEROR IS THE
2 OWNER ON THE" and substitute "TRANSFEROR:";

3 strike lines 7 and 8 and substitute the following:

4 "(a) IS THE OWNER ON THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE, AN OPERATOR,
5 OR A LICENSED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER; AND

6 (b) PROVIDES A COMPLETED BILL OF SALE ON A FORM PRESCRIBED
7 BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

8 (2) A PERSON OTHER THAN A LICENSED MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER
9 WHO PURCHASES OR OTHERWISE RECEIVES A MOTOR VEHICLE FOR THE
10 PURPOSE OF SCRAPPING THE VEHICLE SHALL KEEP THE VEHICLE FOR SEVEN
11 BUSINESS DAYS BEFORE SCRAPPING IT. DURING THE SEVEN DAYS, THE
12 MOTOR VEHICLE, THE BILL OF SALE, AND, IF APPLICABLE, THE DAILY
13 RECORD REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SECTION 42-5-105 SHALL BE OPEN AT
14 ALL TIMES DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS TO INSPECTION BY THE
15 DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE OR ANY PEACE OFFICER."
