After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB06-1343 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee on Appropriations with favorable recommendation:

1 Amend printed bill, page 4, strike lines 15 through 23 and substitute the
2 following:

3 "SUBDIVISION.

4 (4) A STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL NOTIFY
5 THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE IF A CONTRACTOR VIOLATES A
6 PROVISION OF A PUBLIC CONTRACT FOR SERVICES REQUIRED PURSUANT TO
7 SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION AND THE STATE AGENCY OR POLITICAL
8 SUBDIVISION TERMINATES THE CONTRACT FOR SUCH BREACH. BASED ON
9 THIS NOTIFICATION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST
10 THAT INCLUDES THE NAME OF THE CONTRACTOR, THE STATE AGENCY OR
11 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION THAT TERMINATED THE PUBLIC CONTRACT FOR
12 SERVICES, AND THE DATE OF THE TERMINATION. A CONTRACTOR SHALL
13 BE REMOVED FROM THE LIST IF TWO YEARS HAVE PASSED SINCE THE DATE
14 THE CONTRACT WAS TERMINATED, OR IF A COURT OF COMPETENT
15 JURISDICTION DETERMINES THAT THERE HAS NOT BEEN A VIOLATION OF
16 THE PROVISION OF THE PUBLIC CONTRACT FOR SERVICES REQUIRED
17 PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2) OF THIS SECTION. A STATE AGENCY OR
18 POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL NOTIFY THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF
19 STATE IF A COURT HAS MADE SUCH A DETERMINATION. THE LIST SHALL BE
20 AVAILABLE FOR PUBLIC INSPECTION AT THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF
21 STATE AND SHALL BE PUBLISHED ON THE INTERNET ON THE WEBSITE
22 MAINTAINED BY THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE."
