Minors - consent for medical care - pregnancy. 6 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, A PREGNANT MINOR 7 MAY AUTHORIZE PRENATAL, DELIVERY, AND POST-DELIVERY MEDICAL 8 CARE FOR HERSELF RELATED TO THE INTENDED LIVE BIRTH OF A CHILD. 9 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds, 10 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate 11 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
