TITLE: CONCERNING INTERBASIN COMPACTS, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, APPROVING THE INTERBASIN COMPACT CHARTER AND ALTERING THE BOUNDARIES THAT DEFINE CERTAIN WESTERN SLOPE BASIN ROUNDTABLES.

Summary of Assessment

This bill approves the interbasin compact charter, pursuant to the provisions of HB05-1177. The bill requires the revisor of statutes to publish the full text of the charter in the Colorado Revised Statutes as non-statutory matter. The bill also moves water districts 60, 61 and 63 from the Gunnison basin roundtable to the Dolores, San Miguel, and San Juan basins roundtable.

The interbasin compact charter does not, in and of itself, place any additional requirements on the state. In addition, the language of the charter is specified to be non-statutory matter. Thus, this bill does not affect state revenues or expenditures, and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.
