Summary of Amendments Made to the Bill After the 01/29/06 Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note was Prepared (Amended by the Committee on Transportation and Energy 02/02/06)

1. The Transportation and Energy Committee amendment changed the definition of "Full Service Customer" by inserting the word "natural" in the following sentence: "Full Service Customer" means a residential or commercial customer that purchases NATURAL gas supply from a gas distribution utility.

This does not change the fiscal impact of the bill as indicated in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated January 29, 2006.

Amendments/Appropriation Status

The bill does not contain an appropriations clause. Staff has drafted an amendment **J.001** (attached) that inserts an appropriations clause into the bill. This clause appropriates \$84,522 cash funds from the Public Utilities Commission Fixed Utility Fund and 0.8 FTE to the Department of Regulatory Agencies, for allocation to the Public Utilities Commission, in FY 2006-07 to implement the bill. Also, the clause appropriates \$12,890 cash funds exempt to the Department of Law, for legal services, in FY 2006-07 to implement the bill. This clause is consistent with the estimated fiscal impact of the bill as delineated in the Legislative Council Staff Fiscal Note dated January 29, 2006.
