A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING AN INCREASE IN THE LIMIT ON THE AMOUNT OF MONEY**
102 **TO BE COLLECTED AS PENALTIES FOR DELINQUENT PROPERTY**
103 **TAX PAYMENTS THAT THE COUNTY TREASURER IS AUTHORIZED**
104 **TO REFRAIN FROM COLLECTING.**

Bill Summary

Increases the limit on the amount of money to be collected as a penalty, interest, or costs for delinquent property tax payments that the county treasurer is authorized to refrain from collecting.

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** 39-10-104.5 (10), Colorado Revised Statutes, is
3 amended to read:

4 **39-10-104.5. Payment dates - optional payment dates - failure**
5 **to pay - delinquency.** (10) The treasurer may refrain from collecting
6 any penalty, delinquent interest, or costs where the amount to be collected
7 is ~~ten~~ FIFTY dollars or less. Nothing in this subsection (10) shall be
8 construed as releasing any person from the payment of any tax,
9 assessment, penalty, delinquent interest, or costs or any other moneys
10 which are due and owing and which the treasurer is authorized by law to
11 collect.

12 **SECTION 2. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
13 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
14 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
