105	PERIOD FOR THE CONTRIBUTION DESIGNATION.


#### **Bill Summary**

Extends the period that state income tax return forms shall include a line whereby individual taxpayers may make a voluntary contribution to the family resource centers fund.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 SECTION 1. 39-22-2502, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended 3 to read: 4 **39-22-2502.** Voluntary contribution designation - procedure. 5 For income tax years commencing on or after January 1, 2003 JANUARY 6 1,2006, but prior to January 1, 2006 JANUARY 1,2009, the Colorado state 7 individual income tax return form shall contain a line whereby each 8 individual taxpayer may designate the amount of the contribution, if any, 9 the individual wishes to make to the family resource centers fund created 10 in section 39-22-2503. 11 SECTION 2. 39-22-2503 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, is 12 amended to read: 13 **39-22-2503.** Contributions credited to the family resource 14 centers fund - appropriation. (2) The general assembly shall 15 appropriate annually from the family resource centers fund to the 16 department of revenue its costs of administering moneys designated as 17 contributions to the fund. All moneys remaining in the fund at the end of 18 a fiscal year, after subtracting the appropriation to the department of 19 revenue, shall be transferred to the department of public health and 20 environment FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS ASSOCIATION, A COLORADO 21 NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION. The department of public health and 22 environment FAMILY RESOURCE CENTERS ASSOCIATION shall distribute the 23 moneys to family resource centers statewide that operate in accordance 24 with the provisions of section 26-18-104 (2), C.R.S., and such moneys 25 shall be used in furtherance of the work of the family resource centers. SECTION 3. 39-22-2504, Colorado Revised Statutes, is amended 26

39-22-2504. Repeal of part. This part 25 is repealed, effective
January 1, 2007 JANUARY 1, 2010, unless the voluntary contribution to the
family resource centers fund established by section 39-22-2503 is
continued or reestablished by the general assembly acting by bill prior to
said date.

SECTION4. Effective date. This act shall take effect at 12:01 7 8 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the ninety-day period after 9 final adjournment of the general assembly that is allowed for submitting 10 a referendum petition pursuant to article V, section 1 (3) of the state 11 constitution (August 9, 2006, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 12 2006); except that, if a referendum petition is filed against this act or an 13 item, section, or part of this act within such period, then the act, item, 14 section, or part, if approved by the people, shall take effect on the date of 15 the official declaration of the vote thereon by proclamation of the 16 governor.
