102 SECURITY FEATURES FOUND ON DRIVERS' LICENSES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not necessarily reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted.)

Extends the 60ϕ surcharge on drivers' licenses that covers the cost of security features.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. 42-2-114 (2) (a) (I) (F), Colorado Revised Statutes,

2 42-2-114. License issued - fees - repeal. (2) (a) (I) Except as 3 provided in subsection (3) of this section: 4 (F) In addition to the fees imposed in sub-subparagraphs (A) to 5 (D) of this subparagraph (I), the fee for the issuance of a minor driver's 6 or driver's license shall include a sixty-cent surcharge. Such THEMONEYS 7 COLLECTED PURSUANT TO THE surcharge shall be forwarded to the 8 department for transmission to THE state treasurer, who shall credit the 9 same to the identification security fund created in section 42-1-220. This 10 sub-subparagraph (F) is repealed, effective July 1, 2006. 11 SECTION 2. Repeal. 42-1-220 (2) and (3), Colorado Revised 12 Statutes, <u>are</u> repealed as follows: 13 42-1-220. Identification security fund. (2) On or before July 1, 14 2006 JULY 1, 2008, the state auditor shall submit a report to the 15 transportation legislation review committee, created in section 43-2-145, 16 C.R.S., concerning the effectiveness of the security features that are part of the driver's license system in reducing the incidence of issuance of 17 18 fraudulent drivers' licenses and identification cards. 19 (3) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2006. 20 SECTION 3. Repeal. 42-2-306 (1) (a) (V) (B), Colorado 21 Revised Statutes, is repealed as follows: 22 **42-2-306.** Fees - disposition - repeal. (1) The department shall 23 charge and collect the following fees: 24 (a) (V) (B) This subparagraph (V) is repealed, effective July 1, 25 2006. 26 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,
