37 16-22-107 (4) (a) AND IF THE RESIDENCE OF THE PERSON AT THE SHELTER  
38 OR INSTITUTION IS CAPABLE OF VERIFICATION AS REQUIRED BY 16-22-109  
39 (3.5). A person may establish multiple residences by residing in more  
40 than one place or dwelling."

12 IS EARLIER. THE PROVISION SPECIFIED IN THIS SUBPARAGRAPH (I) SHALL  
13 NOT BE REQUIRED OR EFFECTIVE IN A PUBLIC CONTRACT FOR SERVICES IF  
14 THE BASIC PILOT PROGRAM IS DISCONTINUED.
