THE ADJUTANT GENERAL SHALL SELECT THE ORGANIZATION IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COLORADO BOARD OF VETERANS AFFAIRS, CREATED IN SECTION 28-5-702, C.R.S. THE ORGANIZATION SHALL USE THE MONEYS TO AID VETERANS, ACTIVE SERVICE MEMBERS, AND THE FAMILIES THEREOF BUT MAY KEEP UP TO SEVEN PERCENT OF THE MONEYS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. THE ORGANIZATION MAY USE THE MONEYS TO AID VETERANS, ACTIVE SERVICE MEMBERS, AND THE FAMILIES THEREOF BY MAKING GRANTS TO OR SELECTING OTHER NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE THE AID SO LONG AS NO MORE THAN SEVEN PERCENT OF THE MONEYS ARE USED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS. ONCE AN ORGANIZATION IS SELECTED, IT SHALL CONTINUE TO ADMINISTER THE FUNDS UNLESS GOOD CAUSE IS SHOWN FOR REMOVAL.".
