After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

<u>HB06-1132</u> be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:

Amend printed bill, page 6, after line 20, insert the following:

"SECTION 5. Appropriation. In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the animal protection fund created in section 35-42-113, Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of agriculture, for allocation to the agricultural services division, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, the sum of eight thousand dollars (\$8,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act.".

(2) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the mortgage broker registration cash fund created in section 12-61-908 (2), Colorado Revised Statutes, not otherwise appropriated, to the department of regulatory agencies, for allocation to the division of real estate, for regulation of mortgage brokers, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, the sum of ninety-seven thousand three hundred seventy-three dollars (\$97,373) and 1.5 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act.

(3) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated to the department of law, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, the sum of twenty-five thousand seven hundred eighty dollars (\$25,780), and 0.2 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the provision of legal services to the department of regulatory agencies related to the implementation of this act. Said sum shall be from cash funds exempt received from the department of regulatory agencies, executive director's office, out of the appropriation made in subsection (1) of this section.

(4) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated, to the department of public safety, for allocation to the colorado bureau of investigations, for processing of fingerprint-based criminal history checks for mortgage brokers, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, the sum of forty-six thousand eight hundred ninety-four dollars (\$46,894) and 0.6 FTE, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the implementation of this act. Said sum shall be from fingerprint processing fees collected by the Colorado bureau of investigation.

(5) In addition to any other appropriation, there is hereby appropriated to the department of public safety, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2006, the sum of sixty-six thousand dollars (\$66,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for pass through to the federal bureau of investigation for fingerprint-based national criminal history checks for mortgage brokers related to the implementation of this act. Said sum shall be from fingerprint processing fees collected by the Colorado bureau of investigation."
