Jeanne felt blessed in having lived a very full, active life, and in seeing her core values and love of adventure in her children. She leaves behind a 50-year love affair with husband Michael, as well as endless love for daughters Danica (husband Ron) and Emily, brother Joseph (wife Norma), sister Therese (husband Joe Glenn), sister-in-law Janice, and many cousins, nieces, nephews, and dear friends. 
