SUBJECT: Prime Bill Sponsorship 1993 through 2000 and 2003 through 2010

This memorandum lists bills and resolutions that you sponsored during your tenure at the General Assembly. Table 1 lists the bills for which you were the prime sponsor as a State Senator from 2003 through 2010. You were the prime sponsor of a total of 193 bills, memorials, and resolutions during this time. Of this number, 166 were bills and 27 were either resolutions or memorials.

Table 2 lists the bills for which you were the prime sponsor as a State Representative from 1993 through 2000. You were the prime sponsor of a total of 38 bills, memorials, and resolutions during this time. Of this number, 33 were bills and 5 were either resolutions or memorials.
