SUBJECT: Prime Bill Sponsorship 2003 through 2010

This memorandum lists bills and resolutions that you sponsored during your tenure at the General Assembly. You were the prime sponsor of a total of 74 bills, memorials, and resolutions during this time. Of this number, 57 were bills and 17 were either resolutions or memorials.
