34 **INTRODUCTION AND CONSIDERATION OF MEMORIAL**

36 The following memorial was read at length and given immediate  
 37 consideration:

39 **HM91-1001** by Representatives Irwin, Kopel and Knox--Memorial-  
 40 izing Raymond Henderson Black.

43 WHEREAS, By the Will of Divine Providence, our beloved  
 44 former member, the Honorable Raymond Henderson Black, departed  
 45 this life on April 22, 1990, at the age of 89; and

1 WHEREAS, Representative Black was born on December 14,  
2 1900, in Rock Island, Illinois, the son of Frank W. Black and  
3 Lucy H. Henderson Black; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, Representative Black graduated from the  
6 University of Illinois in 1924, the same year he married  
7 Dorothy Algie, and worked as an assistant controller for a  
8 Chicago department store until 1948; and  
9

10 WHEREAS, Representative Black moved to Colorado in 1948,  
11 and owned and operated the Dam Store in the Big Thompson  
12 Canyon for seventeen years; and  
13

14 WHEREAS, Representative Black was a former president of  
15 the Big Thompson Canyon Association, served on the board of  
16 the Thompson Valley Hospital District in Loveland, and was a  
17 member of the Loveland Rotary Club for twenty-two years and a  
18 member of the Boulder Rotary Club; and  
19

20 WHEREAS, Representative Black served this state  
21 faithfully, representing Larimer county in the House of  
22 Representatives from 1956 to 1972; and  
23

24 WHEREAS, Representative Black distinguished himself in  
25 the General Assembly as a former chairman of the Local  
26 Government Committee and as a member of the Business Affairs  
27 and Appropriations committees; and  
28

29 WHEREAS, Representative Black is remembered by his  
30 colleagues as a fair legislator, a respected statesman, and a  
31 determined gentleman; and  
32

33 WHEREAS, It is fitting that we, the members of the  
34 Fifty-eighth General Assembly, pay tribute to the years of  
35 dedicated public service of the late Representative Black and  
36 express our deep regret and sorrow occasioned by his death;  
37 now, therefore,  
38

39 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the  
40 Fifty-eighth General Assembly of the State of Colorado:  
41

42 That, in the death of Raymond Henderson Black, the people  
43 of this state have lost a devoted public servant and an  
44 outstanding citizen and that we, the members of the  
45 Fifty-eighth General Assembly, do hereby extend our deep and  
46 heartfelt sympathy to the members of his family and pay  
47 tribute to a man who served his state well and faithfully.

49 Be It Further Resolved, That copies of this Memorial be  
50 sent to Stanley A. Black and Dale Black, the late  
51 Representative Black's sons.
