NAMED BY A LEGISLATURE.

**Evangeline Hartz Davidson so Called
by the Colorado Assembly.**

Evangeline Hartz Davidson, the first child to be named by a legislative body, was christened at Salda, Colo., recently. The baby is the daughter of Representative J. A. Davidson, of Chaffee county, and the name of Mrs. Evangeline Hartz, member of the House from Arapahoe county, was given it in March last by
