By last Friday, 70 candidates had made the first cut, and will be considered during final jury selection in the courtroom Wednesday.

The prosecution's death team stresses the moment of truth when a prospect may be asked to decide whether Dunlap is to die.

"Can you look Mr. Dunlap in the face and say this person dies by lethal injection?" prosecutor Eva Wilson asks.

A prospective juror, sitting about 5 feet from the 21-year-old defendant, squirms. She gazes away from Dunlap to reply.

"Yes, if a person were unremorseful, I would have no problem. I do believe in reform, though. Even a person in prison for life can reform."

But Wilson continues to press.

"I am trying to get you to predict if you could go to the edge and vote for lethal injection," Wilson says.

In such dramatic exchanges, the prosecutors attempt to weed out any juror who might turn squeamish during final deliberations and opt for a life sentence.

Legislator Moellenberg dies at 59

State Rep. Roland Dean "Bud" Moellenberg died early yesterday at a Yuma County hospital after suffering a heart attack late Saturday at his Kirk home, fellow lawmakers were told.

Moellenberg, 59, a farmer and rancher serving his third term in the legislature, was taken by ambulance to Wray Community Hospital at about 10 p.m. Saturday. He died at about 1 a.m. yesterday, said Chuck Henning, Republican research assistant in the House of Representatives.

Henning said Moellenberg had suffered a heart attack several years ago and had undergone quadruple bypass heart surgery last summer. He said Moellenberg was waiting for a heart transplant and only last week met with doctors to discuss his prognosis as far as undergoing the procedure.

"He's talked to me a lot this year about some of the (health) problems. So, I guess in one sense I'm not surprised," Henning said. "Certainly, he was a popular legislator who got along with everyone on both sides of the aisle and was highly respected by his colleagues."

Moellenberg, R-Kirk, represented House District 63, including the counties of Yuma, Arapahoe, Cheyenne,

Elbert, Kiowa, Kit Carson, Lincoln and Prowers.

He served on the House Agricultural Committee from 1991 to 1994 and was regarded as an expert on southeastern Colorado water and agricultural issues. He was first elected to the House in 1990.

In 1995, he was appointed vice chairman of Education and was a member of the Transportation and Energy Committee.

Moellenberg was born July 5, 1936. He graduated from Colorado State University in 1959 with a bachelor of science degree in animal production. He is survived by his wife, Cheryl, and children, Dalva, 35, Sonya, 34, Gayle, 32, and Jon, 30.

Lewis H. Entz, R-Hooper, said he received the news of his longtime friend's death from House Speaker Chuck Berry.

"I don't know how much more the House can take this year. That's four now," Entz said Sunday in a telephone interview. "Bud and I served together as county commissioners back in the late '60s and '70s and then in the House. It's going to be quite a loss."

Moellenberg's death comes in a week when one of the state's most influential Republican lawmakers is recovering from brain surgery. Rep. Anthony Grampas, R-Evergreen, returned home Saturday after doctors removed a brain tumor last week. He is expected to return to work this week.

Earlier this year, Rep. Jeanne Faatz, R-Denver, was seriously injured in an out-of-state car accident and spent several weeks in a hospital.

Rep. Donald Armstrong, D-Aurora, had surgery on his neck and is still wearing a neck brace, said Berry.

"The death of Rep. Moellenberg on top of that is really depressing," said Berry.

"It's just been a very difficult year," Berry said.

"He was not a flamboyant state representative, but he was very solid and did an excellent job of representing his community, and we're all going to miss him very much."
