WHEREAS, By the Will of Divine Providence, the Honorable Benjamin C. Hilliard, former Justice of the Colorado Supreme Court has departed this life; and

WHEREAS, The late Mr. Justice Hilliard served well and faithfully as Justice of the Colorado Supreme Court for twenty years, and had so gained the respect and confidence of the electorate of the State that shortly before his death he had been elected for a third ten year term; and

WHEREAS, It is fitting that the members of this Assembly give recognition to the devoted public service of Mr. Justice Hilliard and express their deep regret and sorrow occasioned by his death; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-eighth General Assembly, the Senate concurring herein:

That in the death of Mr. Justice Hilliard, the State of Colorado has lost one of its outstanding citizens and we, the members of this General Assembly, desire hereby to extend our heartfelt sympathy to his family and to express our appreciation of the ability and integrity with which he served his State; and
